

Open Burning Permit

Conditions/Restrictions:

1. Weather and moisture conditions must not cause a safety hazard.
2. Materials to be burned: _____

Why is it not practical to take these materials to the landfill? _____

3. Clearance from structures, property lines and combustible material must be:
 - a) Not less than 15 feet when using an approved burning appliance.
 - b) Not less than 25 feet for pile sizes of 4x4 or less.
 - c) Not less than 50 feet for pile sizes greater than 4x4.
4. A person capable of extinguishing the fire **must attend it** at all times and the fire must be totally extinguished before leaving it.

5. A shovel and a minimum of 5 gallons of water or a charged hose **must be** at the burning site and ready to use.
6. Only one pile may be burned at a time and it must be extinguished before starting another.
7. Burning shall be conducted during daylight hours only.
8. If the fire creates a nuisance it **must be extinguished immediately**.
9. When burning on land belong to others (green belt, street, right-of-way, etc) permission from the owner or the owner's designated representative shall be obtained before starting the fire.

I have read and understand the provisions specified above and accept the responsibility to comply with all of the conditions. I understand this permit does not release me from liability for damages resulting from the spread of fire and that violation of these conditions may result in enforcement action.
