

City Council Meeting  
July 9, 2013

Mayor Hanser called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, City Clerk/Treasurer Richards called the Roll Call.

**Consent Agenda:**

Councilperson Jankowski moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Councilperson Stewart seconded the motion. No discussion or public comment received. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Departmental Reports:**

Reports were given by Police Chief Hert, Fire Chief Reid, City Attorney Ryder, Public Works Director Bleth and City Clerk/Treasurer Richards.

**Mayor's Communications:**

Mayor Hanser asked City Council if they would prefer a mail ballot election or traditional poll ballot election. The Rosebud County Clerk and Recorder's Office plans to conduct a mail-ballot election unless the City Council requests the traditional poll ballot. There was no opposition to the mail ballot.

**Public Comment and Participation:**

Rodney Tobler, 3703 Chinook, asked for the City Council to approve payment tonight a bill he submitted yesterday, which is after the deadline for inclusion to be approved at this meeting. He will be moving prior to the next City Council meeting and would like to be paid before then.

Ken Stokes, 11 Sage Court, addressed problems with garbage collection during holiday weeks. He is not happy with his garbage service and will start deducting from his payment if his garbage is not picked up two times per week.

**Unfinished Business:** None.

**New Business:**

Councilperson Jankowski moved to approve the city's response to Olness & Associates audit of fiscal year 2012. Councilperson Stewart seconded the motion. No discussion or public comment received. Motion carried with all in favor.

Councilperson Jankowski moved to approve Resolution No. 2013-R08, declaring some of the street millings as surplus in order to sell it. Councilperson Stewart seconded the motion. No discussion or public comment received. Motion carried with all in favor.

Councilperson Jankowski made a motion to charge \$38.18 per ton for street millings delivered within 5 miles plus \$5.00 per ton per mile over five miles only if there are millings available after using the millings for city purposes and contacting PPL and CPRD. Councilperson Miller seconded the motion. Discussion: Councilperson Williams commented there are several areas in the community that the millings could be utilized including city alleys and the road to the water plant. No public comment received. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Administrative Matters:**

Councilperson Miller moved to amend the agenda to include payment to Rodney Tobler (Rod's Handyman) in the amount of \$8,760. Councilperson Jankowski seconded the motion. No discussion or public comment. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Adjournment:**

Councilperson Stewart moved to adjourn. Councilperson Jankowski seconded. Mayor Hanser adjourned the meeting at 7:54 p.m.
